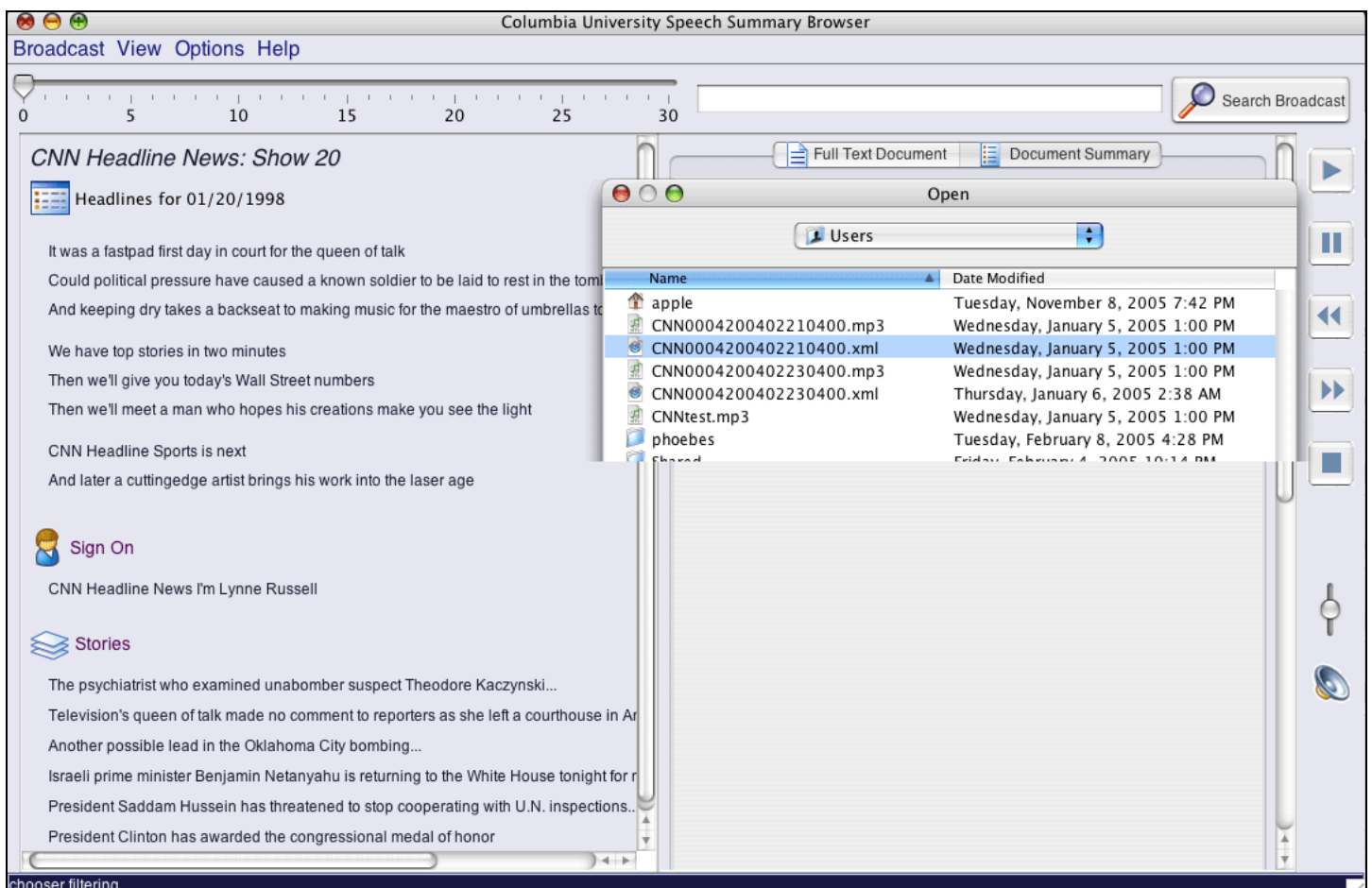


Figure 2. The user chooses a broadcast from the file system.

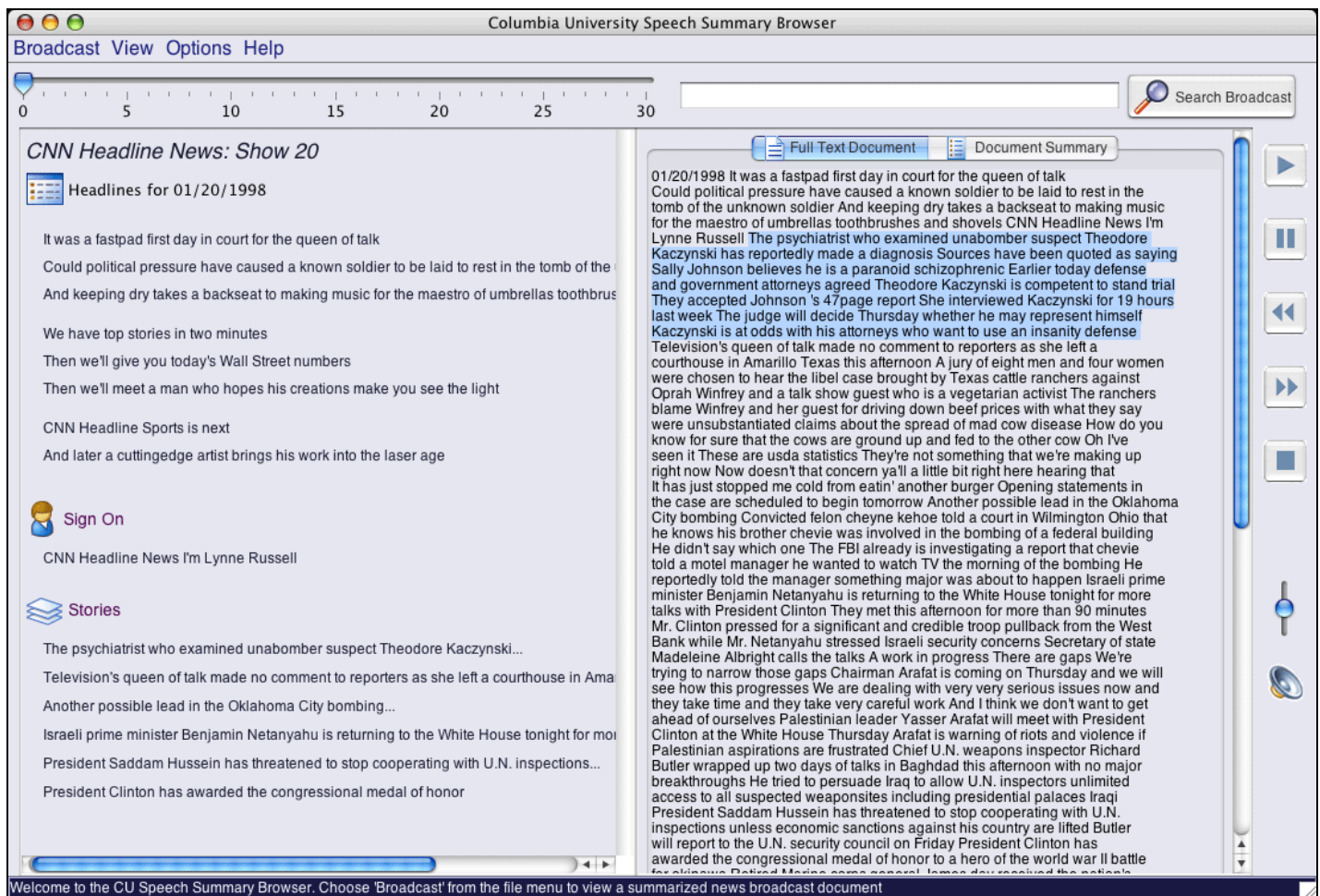


Figure 3. An interactive document outline on the left helps users to navigate the transcript on the right. The user has selected the first story in the 'Stories' list on the left panel, and the corresponding portion of the transcript is highlighted in the right panel.

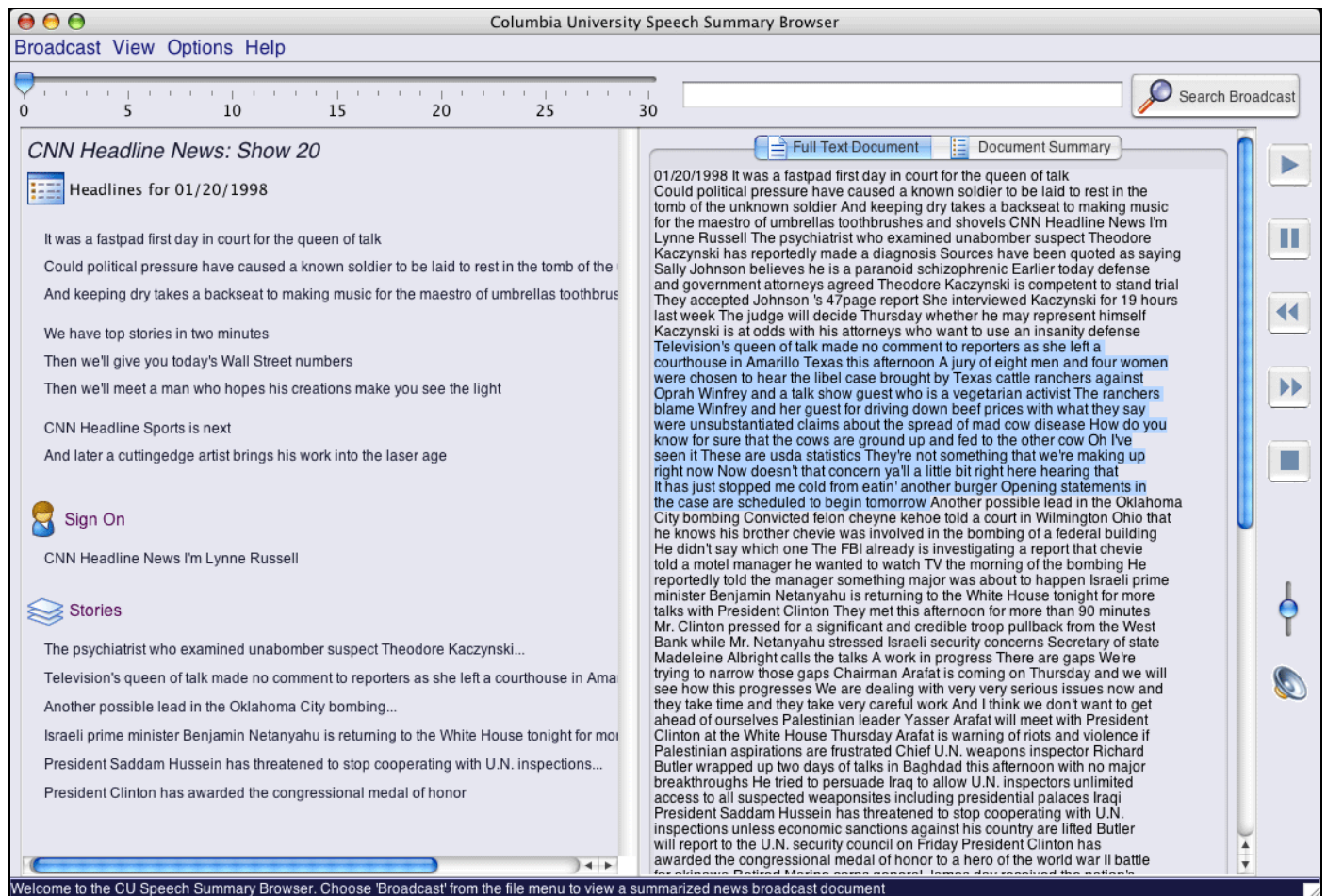


Figure 4. The user has selected the second story from the 'Stories' panel on the left.

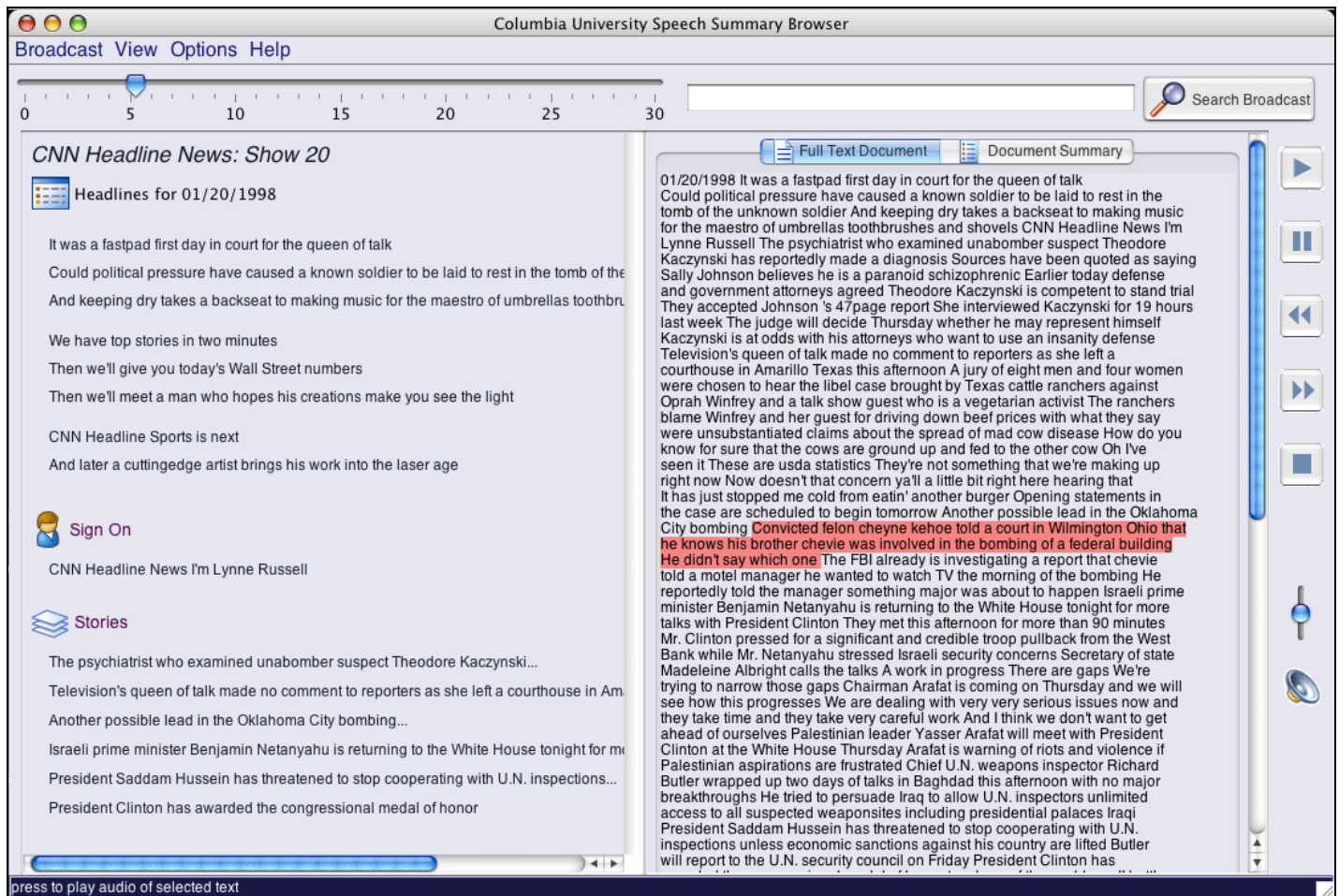


Figure 5. Users can listen to the portion of the broadcast by selecting a portion of the transcript they would like to hear and pressing 'Play'. They can also use the time slider above the panel on the left. Once heard, that portion is highlighted in a different color.

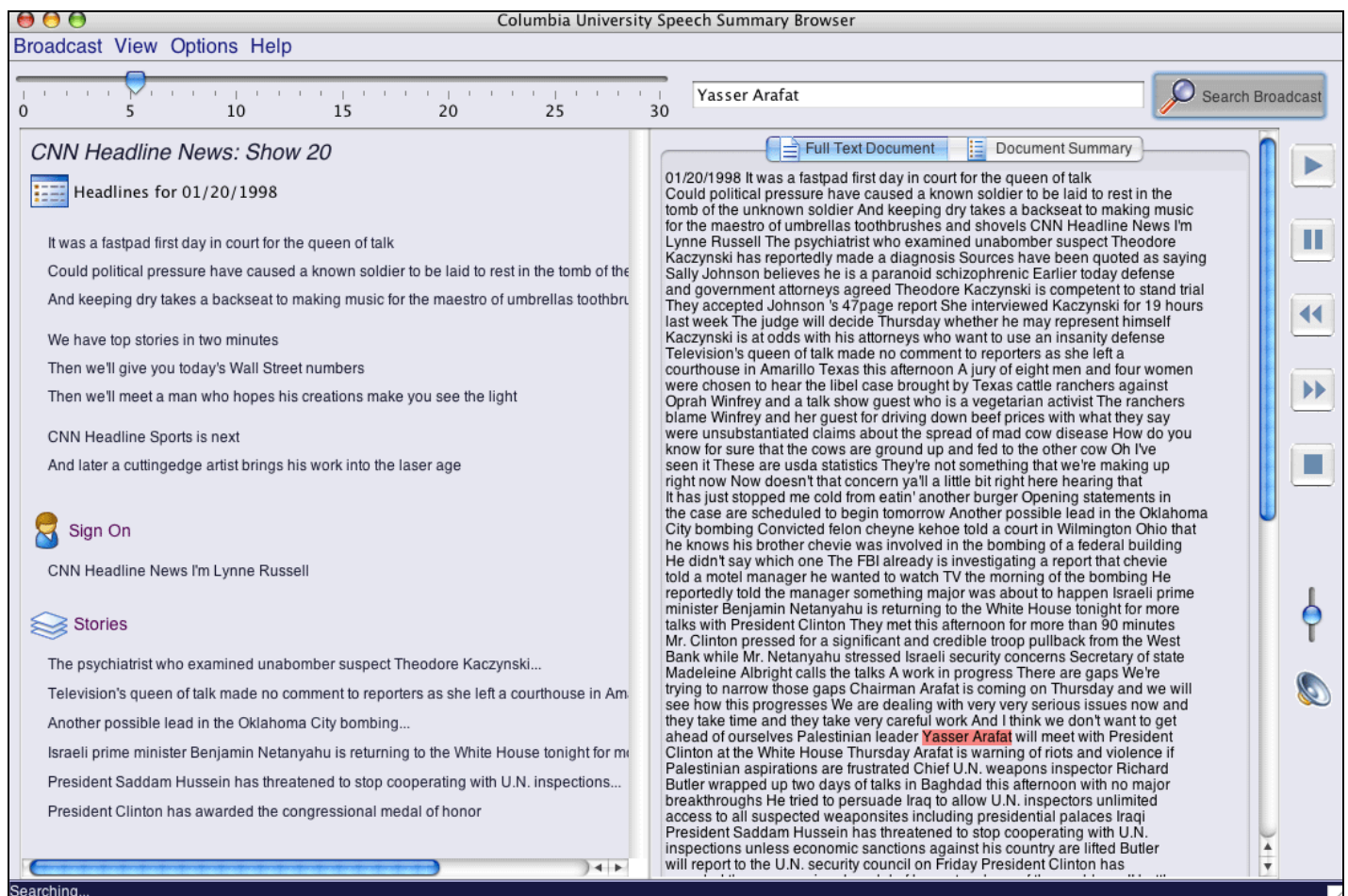


Figure 6. Users can search for terms they would like to find in the document.
